



**FLIGHT RECOMMENDATIONS\***

**Arrival and departure information.** Our program begins the evening of Wednesday, July 6, 2022. When booking your flight, please arrange to be in Israel no later than 4:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 6. Last day of the mission will include a full itinerary. Therefore, please book your return flight to the US to depart NO EARLIER than 11pm (23:00) on Wednesday, July 13. The below recommended (non-stop) flights fit with the mission schedule.

**Please note:** Miami Airport, Fort Lauderdale and Palm Beach Airports offer many flight options with layover. All depend on your personal preferences.

For example: United Airlines offer flights from PB Int'l Airport (PBI) to Israel via Newark Airport (EWR). Delta offers flights from Fort Lauderdale (FLL) via JFK. ElAl as well - using JetBlue on the domestic segment. The same applies for returning to the US.
